

# Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority Regional Auto Theft Training



The Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority (WATPA) will be conducting a series of five auto theft training sessions in Lacey, Snohomish, Ellensburg, Spokane and Kennewick beginning in January, 2012.

The free all-day training featuring members of various WATPA-funded auto theft task forces will provide training on street racing, wrecking yard search warrants and store front operations.

The Washington Department of Licensing (DOL) will provide training on title fraud, dealer services, LIU and other schemes, functions and protocol as it relates to auto theft investigations.

The King County Prosecutors Office will present a legal update and provide insight into related legal topics and participant in a Q&A for auto theft-related investigations.

In addition, a representative from State Farm Insurance's Special Investigative Unit will cover insurance/auto theft investigations and provide specific indicators on what to look for in regards to fraudulent thefts and information on some unknown laws that may help police investigations.
