



MAJOR SCOTT STEPHENS

Scott began his law enforcement career with Spokane Police Department as a Reserve Officer in 1984. In March of 1986, he was hired on full time as a police officer. Scott worked graveyard patrol and served as a Field Training Officer (FTO), TAC Team member, Explorer Advisor and academy instructor. He promoted to Patrolman First Class and in March of 1992 promoted to Sergeant. Scott worked the graveyard shift in addition to instructing at the training center and supervising the Explosive Disposal Unit (EDU). In January of 1995, Scott was transferred to SIU and supervised the drug unit and patrol officers in the Street Crimes Unit. He was promoted to Lieutenant in July of 1997 and served in various divisions with in the department, including: the graveyard patrol shift commander, Information Systems, Major Crimes Unit and Internal Affairs.

Scott was promoted to Major on January 11, 2009 and he currently serves as the commander of the Operations Support and Administrative Bureaus of the Spokane Police Department. He, along with two Captains, oversee the Investigative Divisions, Crime Analysis, Records Division and the Communication Center. Scott has served as commander of the TAC and SWAT teams and is a graduate of the FBI National Academy, Session 220.
